

## Directions to Mary Grace Long's Studio from Interstate 5. 1735 Westlake Ave N, #202 Seattle WA 98109 | 206 624 7474

**Coming from the North:** take the Mercer Street Exit (exit 167) which is just BEFORE downtown Seattle. Exit is on the Right.

Come off the exit ramp and down to the light at Fairview Ave N. Go Right to next light at Valley St. which is immediate. You are at the very south end of Lake Union. Go left here on Valley and immediately get in the far Right lane. Take slight Right on Westlake Ave N. Continue up Westlake for about a half mile. You will see a large 1800 on your right. Go Right into the parking lots and find a spot. Spaces on the east side of the lot (lake side) are 2 hour parking – payment at meter stations per your space number. Spaces on the west side (street side) are all day and free but rarely available except on the weekends. The studio is across the street and south a bit from the large 1800. **Please be aware that the first true lane of traffic looks like a sidewalk. It is not. Please stay up on the bank where plantings are. Cars race this stretch and the light colored paved area is an actual lane.** Our building is Westlake Tower-1735. We are one building South of Fox 13. Main entrance is the double doors on the Northeast side of the building. Building is a grey painted brick with overly neon red doors. My studio is number 202.

**Coming from the South:** take the Mercer Street Exit (exit 167) which is just AFTER downtown Seattle. Exit is on the Left.
